Rajkiya Mahavidyalaya Amori, Champawat is fully included of Kumaoni art and culture. The students here perform Kumaoni art on every occasion and festival.

Uttarakhand is a hilly state, where it is very cold, hence people here have permanent houses. In most of the houses, there is a tradition of eating roti at night and rice during the day. Almost every month some festival is celebrated. On the pretext of festivals, dishes are prepared from time to time in most of the houses. Locally grown pulses like Gahat, Rans, Bhatt etc. are used. In ancient times, Manduwa and Jhungora were local coarse grains. Now their production is very less. Now people buy wheat and rice from the market. Along with agriculture, animal husbandry is done in almost all the houses. Home-produced grains are sufficient for only a few months. People near the towns also do milk business. Mountain people are very hardworking. The work of cutting the mountains and making terraced fields also shows their hard work. Most of the workers in the hills are educated, even if less educated. For this reason, the literacy rate of this state is also much higher than the national average. Traditionally, women of Uttarakhand used to wear ghagra and angadi, and men wore churidar pajama and kurta. Now their place has been taken by petticoat, blouse and saree. Woollen clothes are used in winter.

Uttarakhand is very rich in terms of folk art. Folk art is first seen in the decoration of the house. On auspicious occasions like Dussehra, Diwali, Namkaran, Janeu etc. women make Aampan (Alpana) at home. For this, the house, courtyard or stairs are coated with ochre. Rice is soaked and ground. Attractive pictures are made with its paste. On various occasions, Namkaran Chowki, Surya Chowki, Snan Chowki, Birthday Chowki, Yagyopaveet Chowki, Vivah Chowki, Dhumilardhya Chowki, Var Chowki, Acharya Chowki, Ashtadal Kamal, Swastik Peeth, Vishnu Peeth, Shiv Peeth, Shiv Shakti Peeth, Saraswati Peeth etc. The village women make it themselves.

Garhwal has had an unforgettable place in Indian culture since prehistoric times. In some form or the other, the life of the people here is accessible to see the whole of India. The folk dances here are a sacred means to know this healthy feeling. The people here enjoy various types of folk dances on many occasions.

The main language of Uttarakhand is Hindi. Here most of the government work is done in Hindi. Hindi is spoken in urban areas. Kumaoni is spoken in the rural areas of Kumaon division and Garhwali is spoken in the rural areas of Garhwal division. Devanagari script is used to write Kumaoni and Garhwali languages. 




