### 1- Title of the Practices

"Institution's Social Responsibility – Community Awareness Programmes through NSS"

2- Objectives: "Service to Humanity is service to God"

- To provide Hands-on experience to young students in delivering Community services.
- To give exposure to students in experiential learning beyond traditional classroom learning.
- To involve students in social activities which promote citizenship roles and social networking skills.
- To create a linkage between the college and the Community where they live.
- To allow the students to identify the needs and problems of the Community which in turn helps them to develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Generate awareness in society towards Road Safety, Environment, Health and Voting.
- Develop a sense of social and civic responsibility among ourselves.
- To acquire leadership qualities and a democratic approach.
- To develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- 3- Context: For the upliftment of the nation, governments in the last few decades have initiated and implemented various welfare, upliftment schemes and awareness programs for social welfare. Participation of student volunteers is always essential for effective implementation and result oriented system. At various levels, citizens require assistance and awareness programs in rural areas due to ignorance on various issues. Also, a support network is created to face problems like lack of information about digital facilities, illiteracy, health, carelessness towards voting, safety measures etc. In the college, efforts are being made to sensitize the students through National Service Scheme and Rovers Rangers, Youth Red Cross etc. as a result of which they can serve the needy people selflessly. The following challenges were identified following a survey conducted by volunteers in the community.

- 4- The Practice: The details of the programs to be carried out were scheduled by the NSS unit and the same is informed to the volunteers. Some of the programs implemented under this are as follows
  - "Swach Bharath" Awareness Camp was conducted which was intended to create awareness in the community about the importance of cleanliness of the surroundings.
  - Awareness programs were conducted on "Yoga" and the use of practising yoga and the maintenance of good health.
  - "AIDS" Awareness programs and rallies were conducted making the community aware of ill effects of illegal sexual contacts.
  - "Anti-Drugs rally" for social awareness in society such as Amori and nearest region of the Amori village.
  - "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan: Cleanness drive abhiyan for social awareness in society such as Amori and nearest region of the Amori village.
  - Awareness programs were conducted on "Child poshanabhiyaan, Nutritional Diet & Good health".

## 5- Evidence of success:

- An increase in organizational skills was seen among the students during the organization of various programs in the college.
- A change in people's attitude towards AIDS victims, Road Safety, Health, and Environment could be seen.
- Through this activity/practice education help was offered to students in rural areas by teaching them during the Lockdown period.
- Most of the participating students appeared more sensitized and motivated as their participation in other social activities conducted by the college enhanced.
- The organizational skill among the students appeared to be enhanced while organizing various programmes in the college.

- Positive feedback about the programs from the community is direct evidence of the effectiveness of the practice.
- Awareness has increased in the area as a result of the cleanliness campaign and drug-free rally.

### 6- Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

No major problems have emerged in smoothly implementing the system. Apart from modest financial support, no additional resources were required. The NSS Program Officer of the institute underwent necessary training to undertake various community services inside and outside the college. The Principal of the college has extended full support to the teachers and students for their social services.

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#### Session 2018-19

The first one-day camp of the session was conducted at the College on 24th September 2018 on the occasion of NSS Foundation Day, in which various types of lectures were given by the college professors on important topics related to National Service like cleanliness campaign, Namami Gange, and women's safety empowerment. Went. College professor Dr. Shyam Bachchan gave information related to the establishment of the National Service Scheme, Dr. Siddheshwar Singh discussed the contribution of students in completing Namami Gange, Dr. Subha Singh expressed his views on women empowerment. Dr. Sanjay Kumar expressed his views on the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao campaign, Mr. Ravi Kumar and Mr. Ganesh Chandra gave important information regarding the prohibition of alcohol, and Principal Dr. Kamla Joshi expressed his views on all the above-mentioned points for the students of the college. On 17 December 2018, a one-day camp was organized by the **National Service Scheme Unit** at the college, in the camp the theme of Sparsh Ganga Abhiyan, one step towards cleanliness was highlighted. In the program, a rally was also held in Amori market, in which polythene eradication, cleaning of river etc. Topics like cleanliness etc. were discussed. 24 girl students participated in this program.

### 2019-20

The main topics of the rally were the eradication of polythene, cleaning of river drains, cleaning of the nearby Kwaraila river etc. The principal and Professors addressed the students in the program and made students aware of cleanliness. ## 1- Title of the Practice: Innovative Online Teaching- Learning Methods

## 2- Objectives of the Practice

- Since the time of COVID-19, conducting classes through online mediums and completing the prescribed syllabus on time. At present, e-content is made available to the students as per their requirements.
- To provide good quality study material to students through PPT/PDF/YouTube links etc.
- To try to free students from stress and anxiety due to Covid circumstances. Even at present, keeping the students stress-free by providing online facility of career counselling/roots to roots/skill development training from time to time.
- To keep the knowledge of students updated with the latest emerging areas of innovation/exploration.

### 3- The context :

During the Covid pandemic, every country was forced to impose a lockdown. Offline classes remained closed during the lockdown in every university and college in India. After that, it became a challenge to familiarize the students with the knowledge and complete the syllabus within time. To face the above challenge, it became the responsibilities to complete the courses by running online classes through various mediums available. In all the session according to NEP 2020, online classes and e-content is currently providing to college students.

**4- The practice :** After receiving guidelines from the Uttarakhand government during COVID-19, the head of the institution instructed all the faculty members to conduct classes through online mediums. Since none of the teachers and students had ever seen such a situation before, starting online classes was a major challenge. Teaching faculty and students had to make efforts to learn online methods of teaching and learning like Zoom app, Google Meet etc. Gradually things took shape and students not only adopted the new medium of learning but also excelled in it. in currenty we are providing youtube lecture and e content as per NEP 2020



#### **5- Evidence of success:**

The entire prescribed syllabus is completed within time through offline and online classes. WhatsApp groups have been created for each class in the college. During COVID-19 times, classes were conducted through online mediums. Even at present, few classes are taken through Google Meet and others platform as per requirement. PDFs and PPTs course material are available for that. Few teachers have also created their own YouTube channels to deliver video lectures.

### 6- Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

There were no problems encountered due to this initiative. Students expressed lot of interest and enthusiasm in performing the videos. These activities were done at home atmosphere where students learnt to use available resources and use them effectively.
